

Annual Assessment for CCI Membership

The following is the procedure for calculating each county's annual assessment (or "dues") for membership in Colorado Counties, Inc. (CCI).

1. Counties are categorized in groups based on assessed valuation (AV)

All counties are categorized into eight groups based on the assessed valuation (AV) of property in the county. The eight categories are as follows:

1. AV greater than \$6 billion
2. AV between \$4 and \$6 billion
3. AV between \$3 and \$4 billion
4. AV between \$2 and \$3 billion
5. AV between \$1 billion and \$2 billion
6. AV between \$100 million and \$1 billion
7. AV between \$60 and \$100 million
8. AV below \$60 million

2. A base fee for each category of counties is levied

A base fee schedule is established for each category of counties. The base fee schedule is as follows:

County Assessed Valuation	Base Fee
1. AV greater than \$6 billion	\$45,000
2. AV between \$4 and \$6 billion	\$40,000
3. AV between \$3 and \$4 billion	\$30,000
4. AV between \$2 and \$3 billion	\$20,000
5. AV between \$1 billion and \$2 billion	\$15,000
6. AV between \$100 million and \$1 billion	\$12,000
7. AV between \$60 and \$100 million	\$10,000
8. AV below \$60 million	\$ 6,000

3. A population fee is assessed for counties with a population greater than 10,000

Each county with a population of 10,000 or more is assessed a fee according to the schedule below.

County Population	Base Fee
1. Population of 600,000 or more	\$30,000
2. Population of 500,000 to 599,000	\$25,000
3. Population of 350,000 to 499,000	\$20,000
4. Population of 100,000 to 349,000	\$10,000
5. Population of 35,000 to 99,000	\$ 5,000
6. Population of 20,000 to 30,499	\$ 3,000
7. Population of 10,000 to 19,999	\$ 1,500
8. Population Below 10,000	\$ 0

4. Recalculation each year

Calculations are done yearly using most recent certified DOLA assessed valuation and population figures.
