Motivating participation in Voluntary Agricultural Districts (VADs)	In partnership with the Larimer County Agricultural Advisory Board, facilitate a stakeholder process with interested associations and organizations to identify consensus-based policy avenues for the establishment of a Colorado Voluntary Agricultural District Program. Levy sales tax on outdoor services & experiences	In partnership with the State Tax Policy Interim Committee, explore the pros and cons of applying the county sales tax to recreational services.	Gini Pingnot
Continue to assess county lodging taxes on campsites	Later this year, the Colorado Department of Revenue (CDOR) is expected to cease collection of state and local sales taxes and county lodging taxes on campsites. Explore the feasibility of continuing the collection of county lodging taxes with CDOR.	Gini Pingnot
Levy sales tax in unincorporated areas	Explore the financial viability of levying a sales tax solely in unincorporated areas with willing and interested counties.	Gini Pingnot
Secure voter approval to remove TABOR prohibition on new/increased Real Estate Transfer Tax (RETT)	Explore policy aspects of repealing the RETT provision in the Taxpayer’s Bill of Rights (TABOR) that would have broader appeal, such as limiting its application to highly valued homes or a certain portion of the home’s value. Repeal SB05-152 to allow governments to provide telecommunications service without a citizen vote	Work with the Colorado Broadband Office and various stakeholders as they craft legislation to repeal and replace the statutory provisions in C.R.S. 29-27-101 et seq.	Eric Bergman
Require utility owners to cooperate with road improvement projects	Continue stakeholder process with the goal of improving communication and cooperation between counties and utility owners operating in the county right-of-way.	Eric Bergman
