Bill	Title	Purpose	SFY 2021-2022 Amount
HB21-1030	Expanding Peace Officers Behavioral Health Grant Program (aka co-responder program)	Provided an additional \$1m to the Peace Officers Behavioral Health Support and Community Partnerships Grant Program. In total \$3 million is available in SFY 2021-2022.	\$3 million
SB21-243	Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment Appropriation Public Health Infrastructure	Provides an additional \$10m/year for the next 3 years (\$30 m in total) for distributions to local public health agencies	\$10 million
SB21-260	Sustainability of the Transportation System	Provide sustained funding source for traditional infrastructure (roads and bridges), multimodal options and next-generation infrastructure (electric vehicle charging stations and fleet conversion). Funding consists of dedicated general fund, stimulus dollars and new fees on gas, electric vehicles, rental cars, Amazon deliveries, ride-sharing services and food delivery services (fees will not begin until mid-2022).
