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COVID Safety System Audit and Certification Program



WHAT

Determine what the client wants to achieve.
 Determine client's largest areas of concern.
 Any prior assessment or work that has been done by the client.
 Identify facilities (size, grounds, etc.) will be included in the audit.
 Outline what full compliance with public health regulations means.
 Define what full certification requires.

TIME

Pre-read sent to client followed by 1-hour phone call or Zoom meeting to be conducted prior to site visit.

TOOLS USED/PROVIDED

Pre-audit survey
 Pre-audit checklist
 Process overview



WHAT

Compliance with Federal/CDC, State and Local public health guidelines.
 A gap assessment relative to the guidelines.
 Suggested remedies to achieve compliance.

TIME

Based on facility size (on average: 2-3 hours/facility). If there are multiple facilities, a "train the trainer" program is available for clients to assess additional facilities on their own, if desired.

TOOLS USED/PROVIDED

Federal/CDC, State and Local public health regulations summary.
 Regulations/gaps assessment scorecard.
 Required changes for certification summary (via zoom).



WHAT

Conduct Cohort and Tracing for up to 50 participants via Zoom
 Training will include when and how to elevate contact tracing to Public Health.
 We provided an Online tool for the facility to use for Cohort Tracing and record keeping/tracking.
 Q&A conducted as part of the session to ensure interested parties can have questions and concerns addressed.

TIME

1 Hour Zoom meeting (can be recorded if desired).

TOOLS USED/PROVIDED

Cohort & Tracing training.
 Cohort & Tracing Online tool.
 Zoom meeting/recording.



WHAT

Re-audit the facility for compliance with Federal/CDC, State and Local public health guidelines.
 Issue a non-accredited certificate of compliance.

TIME

Based on facility size (on average: 1-2 hours/facility). There is no "train the trainer" approach for this stage.

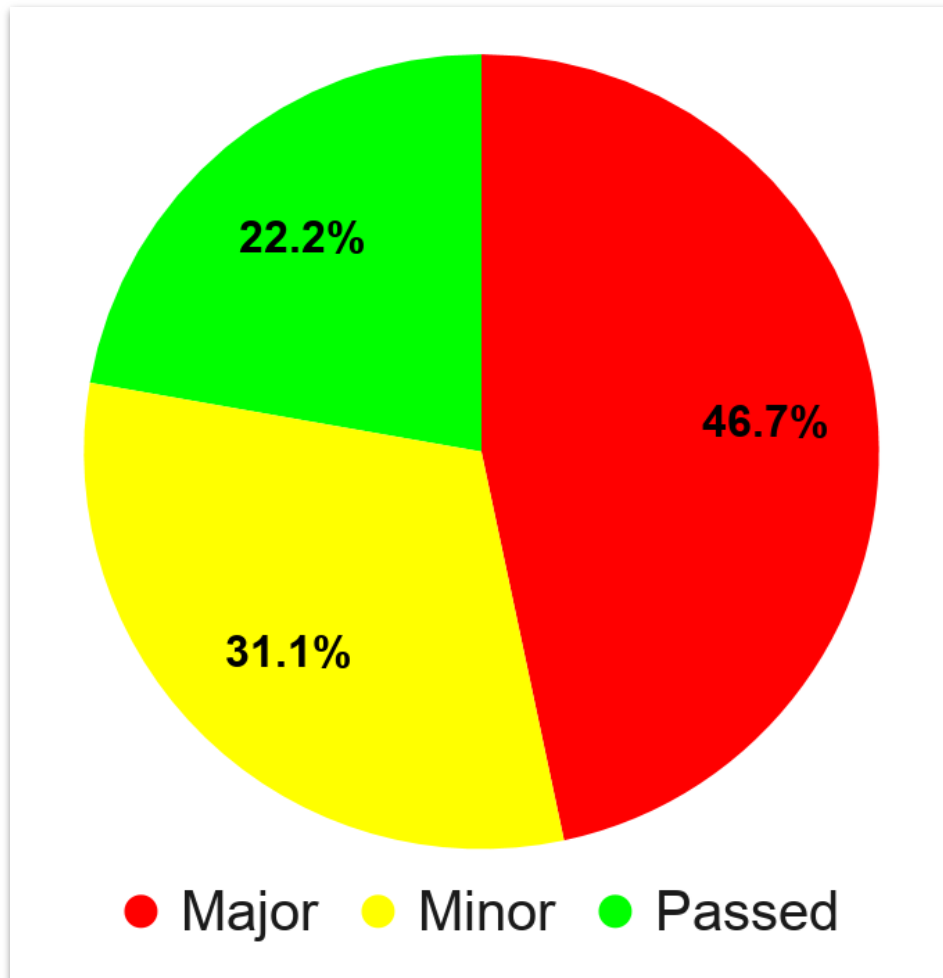
TOOLS USED/PROVIDED

Regulatory compliance report card.
 Certified COVID Safe Facility certificate.

Once certified, H2 will return to the site every 8 weeks to ensure ongoing compliance, and re-issue certification.
