- 1. If you have received a threat from a client that they intend to harm you, co-worker, the facility or any county facility, do the following:

- 4. If you have a client at the CSC that is becoming argumentative, belligerent or verbal with you or a co-worker, call security. They are here to de-escalate and if necessary remove the client from the property. Lobby staff have panic buttons, all other staff are to call ext. 5100 or <u>719-393-2200</u> cell.
