A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EAGLE, COLORADO
SUBMITTING A BALLOT ISSUE TO THE REGISTERED ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF
EAGLE AT THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 COORDINATED ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Town Council has called a special election to be held on November 3, 2020, and to be coordinated with Eagle County, as part of the state general election to submit one or more ballot issues and questions to the registered electors of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TOWN OF EAGLE, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. At the November 3, 2020 election, the following ballot issue shall be presented to the registered electors of the Town:

WITHOUT RAISING THE MILL LEVY FOR THE 2021 TAX COLLECTION YEAR, SHALL THE EAGLE TOWN COUNCIL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO ADJUST THE TOWN OF EAGLE'S MILL LEVY RATE THEREAFTER AS NEEDED FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF MAINTAINING REVENUES THAT MAY OTHERWISE BE LOST AS A RESULT OF STATE IMPOSED REDUCTIONS IN THE RATIO OF ASSESSED PROPERTY TAX VALUATIONS SO THAT THE ACTUAL TAX REVENUES GENERATED BY THE TOWN'S MILL LEVIES ARE THE SAME AS THE REVENUES THAT WOULD HAVE BEEN GENERATED HAD THE STATE NOT IMPOSED SUCH REDUCTIONS, IN ORDER TO ALLOW THE TOWN TO SUSTAIN SERVICES TO THE EAGLE COMMUNITY?
